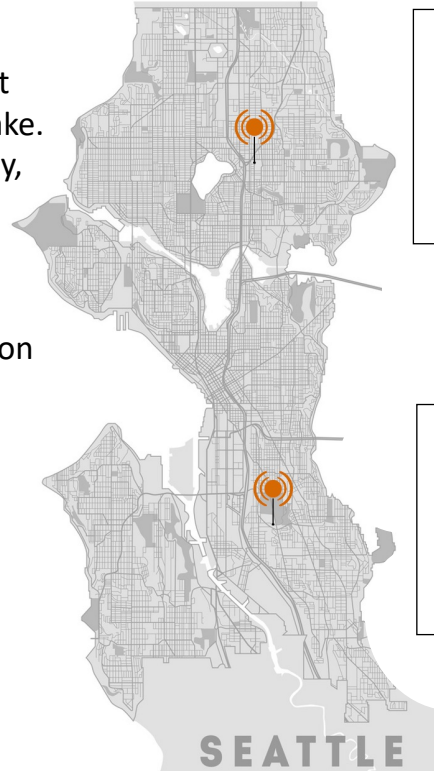
EVERYONE is welcome. In fact, we **NEED you!**
