Meeting called to order at 7:01 PM by President Ann Forrest. Nine people in attendance.

The 23rd Avenue NE drainage project is underway.

There is a homeless encampment on NE 100th Street in the greenbelt across from AirMark.

The Neighborhood Care clothing drive to collect warm coats and sock continues at their Meridian Avenue location.

The Sock Drive concluded with over 400 pairs collected, which includes drop-off locations at Zylberschtein's and pre-school donations.

Winterfest is tentatively scheduled for Sunday, January 28, 2024 from 4-6 PM. We'll need volunteers to help organize, set-up, and break down. There will be luminarias set up around the path in the park and pre-school will be selling cookies.

Rather than going through the work of trying to market gingerbread house kits to the community as a fundraiser, the houses were made and donated directly to Ryther.

Ann wants to step down as President in 2024 (and emergency HUB organizer). We don't have a vice-president in waiting, so hopefully someone will step up to guide the community council next year.
